





Business tool 1 – Virtual library


 Access an extensive library of proven business cases according to your needs and find interactive material and practical examples to understand how to implement similar business cases





Business tool 2 - Guidelines for the supportive business environment


 Pinpoint favourable conditions for innovative business ideas and models: for regions, policymakers, innovation agencies and support actors but also investors and entrepreneurs
